Onboard the USS Ronald Regan Dr. Young set out to treat patients using the full scope of general dentistry: advanced treatment planning, fixed prosthodontics including crowns, veneers, Implant restorations, and endodontic procedures. Dr. Young also functioned as the dental department's training and preventative medicine officer. Dr. Young was one of the first officers to crew swap from the USS Ronald Regan over to the USS Theodore Roosevelt (CVN-71) to bridge the gaps between dental departments in preparation for a smooth transition.
